Eastleigh's Weekly Car Boot Sale:

Eastleigh Borough Council are introducing weekly car boot sales in the Town Centre. Every Saturday 9am to 1pm, from 17 March. The boot sale will take place on the Market Place precinct, alongside the Market.

There is space for 70 vehicles on the precinct. Buyers enter for free and the prices for sellers are £10 for a small/medium car and £15 for a large car, van or trailer. You can hire tables for £5.

It will not take place if there is a major event in the Town Centre.



Eastleigh Community Court Goes Live:

Eastleigh BID have started working with the Community Court to provide resolutions to the young offenders.

The first 2 cases were heard on 27/2/2018. Two 14 year olds were sanctioned at the hearing for shoplifting in the town centre.

They are now having to work with the Town Rangers for two hours, making up for the harm caused to local businesses in Eastleigh town.
